Soil Improvements Work Starts This Month


As part of the **Wall and Soil Improvements Project**, crews will begin 4–5 months of soil strengthening work in August to improve ground stability in the project area (see map).

This work will reinforce the soil to help protect against shifting from earthquakes or heavy rain, supporting the long-term safety of current and future infrastructure.

Expect increased truck and machinery movement near the site and associated noise due to the activity.
