



Taft Avenue Sewer Improvement Project

Construction continues to make steady progress along Taft Ave. in the City of Orange. Work is now moving east on Taft Ave. towards Tustin St., where crews will install the bypass pump system to reroute sewer flow to continue providing reliable service. Pumps will be installed on the northeast side of Tustin St. which will require day and night work at the intersection and result in the closure of the crosswalk. Once this work is completed, work along Taft Ave. will occur during the day.

Location: Taft Ave. and Tustin St.

- Traffic control will be in place until bypass installation is complete.

When: As early as week of October 20, 2025* - two days

Hours: Day Work: 8:30 a.m. - 4 p.m.*

Night Work: 8 p.m.- 6 a.m.*

Impacts:

- Turns may be temporarily restricted- please follow posted signs and plan commute accordingly
- North/south crosswalk on northwest Tustin St. will be closed following the bypass installation, follow detour
- Four-way flashing red traffic signal at intersection as work is occurring
- Expect dust, noise, and increased activity near the construction zone
