PROJECT NO. J-133 LABORATORY REPLACEMENT AT PLANT NO. 1

October 3, 2025

The Orange County Sanitation District (OC San) anticipates publishing a Request for Proposals (RFP) for the above-mentioned project in March 2026.

OC San will hold an industry forum event on Monday, October 20, 2025, from 8:30 A.M – 11:00 A.M. The event is open to design-builders, consultants, subconsultants, contractors, and subcontractors with relevant expertise and interest in supporting this project. Attendees will learn general details about the project and have the opportunity to network with other professionals interested in the project.

PROJECT BACKGROUND

OC San is responsible for the collection, treatment, and disposal of wastewater for the north part of Orange County, California. OC San operates and maintains two treatment facilities: Plant No. 1 in Fountain Valley, CA and Plant No. 2 in Huntington Beach, CA. The treatment facilities currently process an average of 180 million gallons of wastewater per day (mgd). OC San operates a laboratory on its premises to perform sampling, analysis and reporting to document OC San's exemplary regulatory compliance, inclusive of air, biosolids water recycling and ocean discharge. The Laboratory Building, originally constructed in 1989 and 1990, is a two-story building of approximately 36,000 square feet that has undergone several enhancements and/or improvements over the past three decades. There are various issues with the building including multiple code compliance and seismic deficiencies, and the building's major systems are nearing the end of their useful life and requires replacement.

GENERAL SCOPE OF WORK

The project will replace the existing Central Laboratory Building at Plant No. 1. The new lab building will be located at 18350 Mt. Langley Street, Fountain Valley, CA, which is the same location as the existing commercial office building owned by OC San, and is adjacent to the new Headquarters Building. The project includes the demolition of the existing commercial office building and the construction of a new 56,000 SF laboratory in its place. The total progressive design-build (PDB) budget for the project is estimated at \$99 million, which is inclusive of all pre-construction, A/E fees, construction, FF&E's, design-builder contingency and escalation to mid-point of construction. OC San is seeking proposals from qualified design-build teams for the design and construction of the new lab facility.
