



**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING  
REGARDING PROPOSED RATE CHANGES FOR  
WASTEHAULER PERMITTEES**

You have received this notice because our records indicate that you operate a business which discharges wastewater to the facilities of the Orange County Sanitation District (OC San) pursuant to a duly issued wastehauler discharge permit.

OC San has recently completed an updated sewer service fee rate study to ensure that the proposed rates are appropriate and reasonable for all of our customers.

OC San is proposing a rate increase in order to pay projected costs of inspection, repair, operation, maintenance, debt service and reserves needed for OC San's regional collection and treatment system. As a hauled wastewater discharger within OC San's service area, your operations and maintenance charges along with property tax revenue, sewer service fees and other sources of income will pay for these services. Miscellaneous fees, Cost of Analysis Fees and Permit Fees will also increase.

The letter or email must be received prior to or during the public hearing on March 22, 2023.
