### WHAT

There will be a temporary disruption to water service.

Water service disconnections for the buildings being demolished require the temporary shut down of the main water line.

We apologize for the inconvenience.

### WHY

Four buildings located north of Ellis Avenue between Bandilier Circle and Pacific Street are being demolished. The property site for the demolition will be the location of a new OCSD Headquarters Building.

Once the buildings have been demolished, the site will be prepped for the future construction of OCSD's new Headquarters building anticipated to start construction in the fall of 2021.

### ABOUT US

The Orange County Sanitation District (OCSD) is a public agency that provides regional wastewater collection, treatment, and recycling services for approximately 2.6 million people in central and northwest Orange County. OCSD operates two facilities – Reclamation Plant No. 1 in Fountain Valley and Treatment Plant No. 2 in Huntington Beach – and treats an average of 189 million gallons of wastewater each day.
