



Los Alamitos Trunk Sewer Project

Location: Seal Beach Blvd. from St. Cloud Drive to Lampson Avenue in Seal Beach

Construction Activity – Nighttime

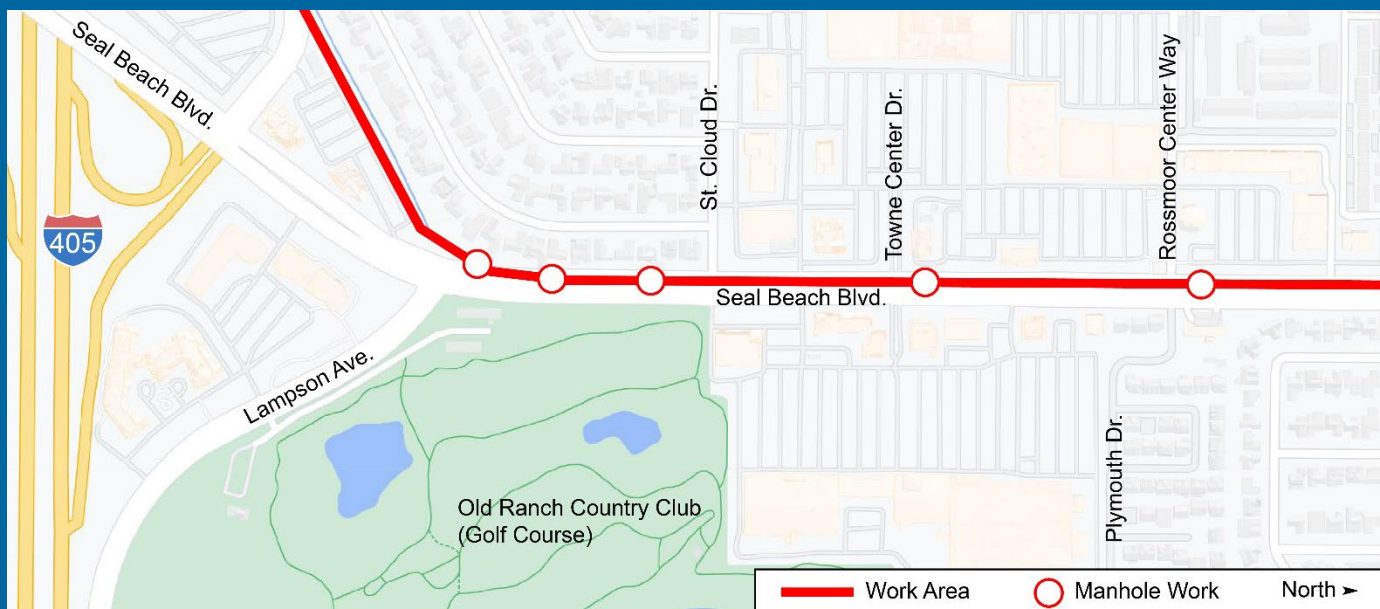
Construction work is ongoing on southbound Seal Beach Blvd. in Seal Beach to repair and replace regional sewer system manholes. The manholes between Bradbury Rd. and Rossmoor Center Way are under construction, the ones between St. Cloud and Lampson Ave. will commence the week of February 20. Each manhole replacement will take approximately 3 weeks to complete. Final street restoration will take place once all work is completed.

Schedule: Mid-February – April 2023

Manhole Replacement - nights

- Monday – Friday, 6 p.m. to 6 a.m.
 - The extended work hours are to allow for the louder construction work to occur before 10 p.m.
 - Construction on Seal Beach Blvd. from Rossmoor Center Way and Bradbury Rd. is taking place from 9 p.m. to 6 a.m.*

- Occasional turn restrictions
- Increased noise – mitigation measures will be in place to minimize impact to the community.
